With regards to the FY18 Medicaid shortfall, discussed at the previous meeting, a payment of \$65,000 was just received, due to back billing. With this, the potential loss in the School Based Mental Health program, also discussed at the prior meeting, has been eliminated, but the ESC will still not receive as much Medicaid as it has in the previous years. The Treasurer reviewed the "FY18 "Final Appropriations and Estimated Revenue" for approval later in the meeting. Also reviewed were the "FY19 Temporary Appropriations and Estimated Revenue" and the "FY19 Liability Insurance Renewal", both for approval later in the meeting.

Superintendent's Report

The Superintendent reviewed her monthly update to the Board, which included an update of the Strategic Plan.

The MHRB of Clark, Greene and Madison Counties met on June 5, 2018 and approved the annual financial support of the Greene County ESC Mental Health Program. The MHRB also approved an additional estimated \$80,000.00 to support PAX and Prevention Services, for one year only.

The results/recommendations of the Energy Audit performed by Energy Optimizers was discussed with the Board. The cost to retrofit the current fluorescent lighting to LED Tube lamps was detailed as well as the reduced future energy costs that would be realized from the change.

It was announced that the Greeneview and Friends Springs Preschool programs are part of the Ohio Striving Readers Literacy Program through the Ohio State Research Foundation and will share in the \$1,161,233.00 awarded the consortium.
