- ■People spend over 700 billion minutes per month on Facebook.


Activity on Facebook




- When you first make a

 Button




Facebook I


- ■Turn on "Console Safety"

- ■Once here you will now want to select it.




- ■Once here select BD "Parental Controls". BD stands for Blu-Ray disc's, which are movies.

■Once you have your BD parental controls set you can now skip back a page and select "Parental Control" for game restrictions.



- Level 1 4 : Rated E for Everyone
- Level 5 8 : Rated T for Teen
- Level 9 11: Rated M For Mature
- Off : No Parental Controls, users can play any games.
- Once finished you can now exit all parental controls.
